The cost of homework journals, locker rental, photocopying and class resources, 24/7 insurance for every registered student is not provided by the Department of Education and Skills. **From 2019/2020 school year the school is introducing a fee of €125 towards these costs, in line with the majority of schools.**

You should know that the school cannot provide a locker or student journal without payment of this charge.

A separate letter will be issued specific to each Year Group and will detail the cost of general expenses. The letter will be sent to all students in mid-June 2019. It will require completion and MUST be returned to the school. Failure to return this important annual registration document may mean your child’s school place will be forfeited.
